- ** The DISPLAY WIDTH is the size of the exhibit when displayed to its' best. Ie a Loco would be best viewed at the side so a 90cm long 5" gauge locomotive could have the dimensions of: 90 (DISPLAY WIDTH) x 30 (DEPTH) x 25 (HEIGHT)
- **#** Other information that helps us plan the exhibit location or handle and place it on the day. Fragile is common but it is useful to know how it can be picked up ie. LIFT on BUFFERS ONLY.
